

**MINUTES OF MEETING

The regular meeting of the Common Council, of the City of Monticello, Indiana, was held on October 17, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 pm by Mayor Cathy Gross and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Doug Pepple made a motion to approve the rezone petition 1156 as presented. Kim Kramer seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.
- 2. Brand Tech-Quote on IT Server Upgrades**-After discussion regarding the details of the quote from Brand Tech Bill Cheever made a motion to move forward with the server upgrades in the amount of \$61,651.42 with the funds to be encumbered from CCD. Dan Oldenkamp seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.
- 3. Transfer Ordinance 2022-18-Council Gasoline Line Item**-Ken Houston made a motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2022-18 transferring \$40,000.00 from Court/Legal to Gasoline. Kim Kramer seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.
- 4. Accounts Payable Vouchers**-Bill Cheever made a motion to approve the vouchers as presented. Dan Oldenkamp seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

Miscellaneous and All Other Matters- Doug Pepple reported that the Rotary Road Rally Event raised approximately \$7,000.00 for the Parks Department. Mayor Gross said that “Trunk or Treat” will be on October 29th from 3-5 pm and “Trick or Treat” following from 5-7 pm.
