## MINUTES OF MEETING BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY CITY OF MONTICELLO MONDAY JULY 20, 2015

- 3. Police Department-permission to hire 2 Part Time Receptionists. Grace Oilar made a motion to give the Police Department permission to hire Samantha Juris and Stephanie Green. Andy Harmon seconded. All ayes, motion carried.
